Finally, we will make sure to include elements you need and/or want to work on in the program for your immersion such as **grammar points, situational speaking practice, phonetics...**

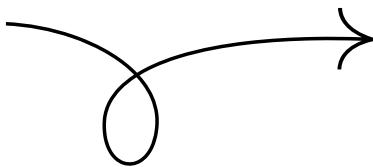

For guests traveling internationally, your journey will usually begin at a major international airport. We strongly recommend choosing one of the **Paris airports (CDG or Orly)**, where you will have access to a wide range of direct flights to **Pau-Pyrénées Airport (PUF)**.

From Pau-Pyrénées Airport, you can:

- rent a car and drive directly to Issor,
- take a shuttle or taxi to Pau train station and continue by train,



There are also **direct trains to Pau from Paris and several major French cities.**

From Pau, you can take a connecting train to either Oloron-Sainte-Marie (16 minutes from Issor) or Lurbe-Saint-Christau (8 minutes from Issor), where we will be happy to pick you up.



Upon request and at an additional cost, **we can arrange a private shuttle service to pick you up from Pau airport or Pau's train station and take you directly to Issor.**

VISITS



OLORON STE MARIE

DISTANCE : 13KM

This Romanesque jewel anchors a charming old town where one shop has been open for 400 years. Two rivers meet here, creating the perfect backdrop for a cultural and gourmet stroll.



LESCUN AND THE ASPE VALLEY

DISTANCE : 28KM

A breathtaking alpine amphitheater: stone villages, soaring peaks, panoramic roads. Ideal for an easy hike or simply a "wow moment" from the car. Don't miss Bedous, Borce, and Aydius.



PAU, ITS CHÂTEAU & THE BOULEVARD DES PYRÉNÉES

DISTANCE : 45KM

The epitome of French elegance: Henri IV's château, café terraces overlooking the mountains, chic boutiques. Perfect for a sophisticated urban day.



THE ARTOUSTE TRAIN

DISTANCE : 66KM

A one-of-a-kind experience: a tiny mountain train - the highest in Europe - skimming cliffsides, offering extraordinary views over alpine lakes and rugged summits.



THE JURANÇON VINEYARDS

DISTANCE : 45KM

Golden hillsides, sweeping Pyrenean views, and premium tastings at family-owned estates. A must for lovers of aromatic, elegant wines. While there, stop in Monein to admire Saint-Girons Church, famed for its extraordinary timber frame.



NAVARRENX, FORTIFIED BASTIDE

DISTANCE : 35KM

One of France's most beautiful villages, encircled by ancient ramparts. Peaceful and charming—perfect for wandering cobbled streets, meeting artisans, and enjoying a terrace drink.



A BASQUE COUNTRY ESCAPE

DISTANCE : 70KM - 115KM

A perfect day trip into the vibrant Basque spirit: wander the cobbled streets of Saint-Jean-Pied-de-Port, gateway to the Camino; then continue to the stunning coastline, from elegant Biarritz to historic Bayonne. Expect striking architecture, bold colors, ocean vistas, and a culture as warm as it is distinctive.

DISTANCE : 44KM - 71 KM

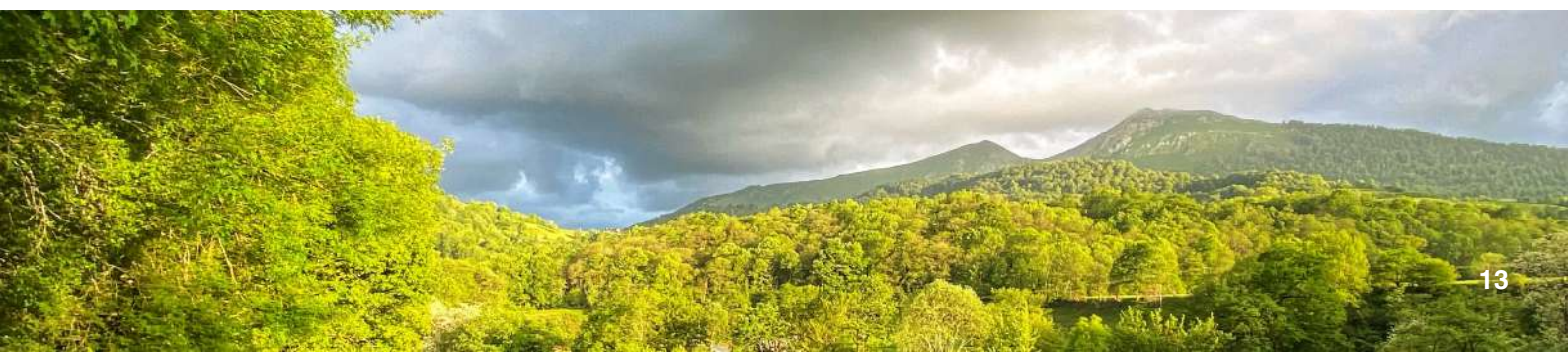
